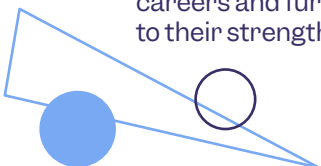

They take on design team roles like production manager, stage manager, technical director, among others.

Make a You Turn.

All Apex Arts applicants must complete an audition to be considered for eligibility. Apex Design & Production portfolio requires **1 or a combination of** any of the following:

- A portfolio of visual artwork (can use the one required for VA audition).
- Written narrative describing a character's perspective of experience.
- Visual storyboard showing costume choices for each character or set designs for a well-known fairy tale.
- A 3D model or diorama of an original set design for a well-known fairy tale.
