Apex Theatre focuses on nurturing well-rounded, passionate students through commitment to the craft of theatrical performance. Students will regularly perform their work for the public, learn from guest teaching artists in Master Classes, and experience professional theatre productions for exposure to the art form.

Apex Theatre students have access to dedicated professional level performance spaces, professional level technology and equipment, and an extensive costume and props shop. Students are mentored by professional sound, lighting, and scenery designers who support their performances.

Apex Theatre students will study acting technique, performance, history, and stagecraft. They will build a comprehensive, cumulative portfolio.

Middle school students will be introduced to theatre as an artform through the exploration of performance and production techniques.

High school students will study acting performance with a foundation in Stanislavsky acting technique. With this approach, students explore connection, communication, physicality, and imaginiation individually and as an ensemble. The program offers a balance of devised and produced work for a well-rounded experience.

- 2. Small group ensemble exercise/improv activity.
- **3.** Short interview to discuss interest in the program and Prime.
