High School Student Schedule

The High School schedule is aligned to the county's high school schedule—8:30–3:18 with 70 minute A/B class periods. Students are engaged through presentations, peer collaboration, and asynchronous explorations. During synchronous learning, it is essential that teachers and students are fully engaged in learning. Learning is a multisensory process and teachers need to see and interact with students to provide the best learning experience. Thus, students and teachers are required to have their cameras on so that meaningful engagement and learning can take place. During these periods attendance is mandatory.

Daily "Team Time" is offered for 40 minutes to support student wellness and connection. This includes Academic Coaching and Office Time on Monday and Friday and Co-Curriculars Tuesday and Thursday. During WISE Wednesday, students engage and connect with synchronous opportunities that include social/emotional activities, Toolkit for Success lessons, and/or Advisories.

In addition to courses offered by our educators, Maryland Virtual Learning Opportunities are embedded. These Maryland Virtual Learning Opportunities (MVLO) recognize AP pursuits in addition to ECAP access.
