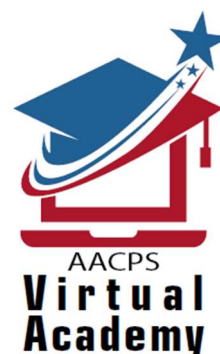


AACPS Virtual Academy Co-Curricular Offerings
