Middle School Creative Writing Auditions

- All students interested in Apex Arts must complete an online application here.
- All applicants must complete an audition to be considered for the program. •
- Audition appointments will be automatically scheduled by the application system. Please plan accordingly.
- All applicants must pass the auditions and meet academic requirements to be eligible for the lottery.
- All students expressing interest in Apex Arts are highly encouraged to audition, regardless of previous training or experience level.

Creative Writing Audition Components

A Creative Writing audition consists of:

- **Portfolio: 2 Written Works**
 - Submit two (2) original written works from different writing genres, selected from the following:
 - Poetry/Song \cap
 - Prose Fiction-short stories, an excerpt novel or longer work 0
 - Short Scene from a Play with notes for stage directions
 - Myth, Tall Tale, or Fairy Tale 0
 - Comedy Routine or Parody 0
 - All written pieces submitted must be typed using Times New Roman, size 12, double spaced, and maximum of 300-350 words.
 - Label each work with your name, the genre, and date. Example: Jane Smith, Poem, Nov. 0 2022
 - Entries must be your own original work (not copied!)





- Be prepared to reference your portfolio pieces at the audition.
- Audition Prompt: Writing Prompt
 - Writing prompt will be given at the time of audition, either in person or virtually.
 - Students will have 30 minutes to complete a written response.
 - All writing materials will be provided for in-person audition. If auditions are virtual-you will need a blank sheet of lined paper and a writing utensil.
- Interview
 - Be prepared to discuss your interest in Apex Arts, your portfolio, and potential as an artist.

Scoring Criteria

You will be scored on the following criteria for each piece:

- **Organization:** The entry is well organized. Ideas or thoughts follow another in logical sequence with clear transitions.
- **Content/Style:** A strong, fully developed theme or main idea is established with several supporting details.
- Mechanics: Very few minor errors in grammar, spelling, capitalization, punctuation and sentence structure.
- **Creative Expression:** Creative approach to the writing or idea. The work is original with a strong sense of personal expression of ideas and meaning.
- Following Portfolio Guidelines: The entries represent a range of genres. The entry is typed and formatted correctly according to the directions provided.

Middle school applicants must score at least an average score of 6 on their audition AND meet academic requirements to be eligible for this program.

Recommendations for Preparation.

- See your school counselor for assistance with the application or for more details about the academic requirements.
- Get feedback on your portfolio pieces from a teacher at your school, ask questions about the prompts if you are unclear about what is being requested.
- Practice for the interview by speaking with various people about your interest in Creative Writing and Apex Arts.
