# **PVA Middle School** Encore Block Scheduling Guidelines

## **Notes**

### **ALL Grades:**

- PVA Prime classes must be scheduled in a DOUBLE BLOCK format in each grade level.
- Enrollment in PVA Courses is restricted to PVA Students. Approval from the PVA Office is required prior to enrolling Non-PVA Students in PVA Courses and must be approved annually.
- PVA Students are to be enrolled in ONE SEMESTER each year of PE/Health and can be scheduled in either the Fall or Spring Semester.
- PVA students cannot be withdrawn from PVA classes or the school without being formally exited from the program.

## World & Classical Languages (WCL) in PVA

- MS WCL Requirements align with the WCL prerequisite for HS Magnet programs. Failure to complete at least one credit of a WCL prior to consideration will deem a student ineligible for ALL AACPS High School Magnet programs.
- **6th GRADE**—PVA students who require reading intervention are excused from the required World Language course in 6th grade.
- **7TH GRADE**—PVA students MUST be enrolled in a WCL Class. Returning PVA students must enroll in the school's designated language (Bates Italian, Brooklyn Park French).
- 7TH GRADE—Students NEW to PVA, or who received reading intervention in 6th Grade are not restricted in their WCL selection. These students will be required to complete Level 1A in 7th grade & 1B in 8th grade to satisfy the completion of one credit of WCL.
- 8TH GRADE—PVA students MUST be enrolled in a WCL Class, and are not permitted to change their language between 7th & 8th Grade.
- WCL2 Hybrid
  —PVA Students who have completed WCL
  1A and 1B will be enrolled in the WCL2 Hybrid course. This
  is a combination between traditional seat hours and a
  Rosetta Stone supplemental resource. Students successfully completing this course will receive 1 WCL credit toward
  their graduation requirement.

#### Intervention in PVA

- Students entering the MS PVA program agree to forego access to daily interventions by virtue of the acceptance of the terms of their PVA Magnet Contract.
- 6th GRADE—PVA students who require reading intervention are excused from the required World Language course in 6th grade
- 7th GRADE—Intervention can be supported during a student's encore choice for one semester only. Alternative WCL scheduling/offerings may be considered if additional intervention is required.
- 8th GRADE—Intervention can be supported during a student's encore choice for one semester only. Alternative WCL scheduling/offerings may be considered if additional intervention is required.
